WHAT IS A NAMED FUND?

A FORCE Named Fund provides donors with the opportunity to make gifts that will have a lasting impact while recognizing your family, or honoring or memorializing a loved one.

Groups or businesses can establish a Named Fund which publicizes your commitment to families at risk for hereditary breast and ovarian cancer.

Named funds:

- Are recognized on our website and in our annual report
- Have a dedicated page and donation process to allow gifts to be given directly to the fund.
- May be directed to a certain area or program such as scholarships, education, research or advocacy.

Named funds offer a way to permanently honor or remember a person or family whose life has been impacted by hereditary breast or ovarian cancer.



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SETTING UP A NAMED FUND

The minimum initial donation to set up a fund is \$10,000.

This amount can be via a single donation or a recurring donation over the course of a year.

A total of \$2,500 per year (total of all donations to the fund during a single year) is required to keep the fund active in subsequent years.

Funds that reach a donation level of \$100,000 are permanent funds and are not subject to an annual \$2,500 minimum.
